

ELEMENTARY UNIFORM POLICY 2020-2021

GAA uniform guidelines are communicated at time of admission or visit the GAA website for information. The student uniform is compulsory and students are to arrive at GAA in their complete school uniform.

Uniform Guidelines

- All black shoes
- Socks: Solid black, blue or white
- If girls wear leggings/stockings/pantyhose/tights under their skirts, color must be solid navy blue or black
- <u>Ties must be worn</u> with the oxford shirt at all times during the school day
- For Physical Education, Athletic shoes must be worn

Don't miss out on celebrations for being on time and wearing full uniform!

GAA may not require uniforms whilst participating in after or out of school activities or on designated special dress days. However; students should be properly dressed in a manner that is not offensive to our host country. The following rules will apply:

- No tight clothes
- No spaghetti strap shirts
- No exposed midriff
- No hoodies
- No offensive logos or expressions on clothing

Personal Presentation:

Students are expected to arrive at school and depart from school in **FULL SCHOOL UNIFORM**. During school hours and while in school uniform, the following rules apply:

- No make-up or jewelry is allowed
- Students with pierced ears may wear one pair of studs or tiny hoop earrings.
- Rings should be small without edges or loose parts
- Necklaces should not be visible
- Except for tasteful natural color highlights, students are not allowed to dye their hair.
- No visible body piercings
- Non-regulation outerwear may not be worn in school; it should be kept in lockers.

Please Note: Students can wear the PE uniform for the entire school day on days when the student has PE classes scheduled.

On swim days, students should wear their GAA school uniform and bring the recommended school swim kit.

Recommended swim kit includes:

- Dark blue/navy swimwear
- Dark blue/navy swim cap for long hair below collar line
- Towels to dry off
- No watches or bracelets
- Flip-flops/sandals should be brought to be used in case of fire alarm, school shoes will be used in lieu of forgotten flip-flops/sandals
- Goggles are recommended
- Plastic bag is recommended to put wetsuit in after class

All **Kindergarten** students need to have an extra set of clearly labeled uniform clothing (shirt, shorts, underwear, and socks) sent to school in a Zip- Lock bag in case a spare is needed.

Due to the current Covid-19 situation, we would like to inform that the uniforms for GAA will only be distributed from Threads' Retail outlet in Capital Mall. There will be no uniform sale from the GAA school uniform store.

Threads is implementing a pre-booking facility on Threads' website where every parent need to pre-book their visit at a date and time (from the available time slots) that is convenient to them before visiting the Threads' Retail Store to purchase the uniforms. This would help to manage/restrict the number of parents visiting the Retail outlet in line with the Covid-19 measures.
